1. Introduction

The Bargersville Parks and Recreation Department is seeking quotes from qualified and experienced contractors to provide routine mowing, lawn care, and landscape maintenance services at seven (7) municipal locations owned by the Town of Bargersville. This RFQ is issued in accordance with applicable municipal procurement policies and state purchasing laws.

2. Scope of Services

The successful contractor shall provide all labor, equipment, materials, and supervision necessary to perform the services and ensure the aesthetic appeal and safety of areas as described in this RFQ. (specific locations and detailed services in Exhibit A):

A. Turf and Mowing Services:

- Weekly mowing of lawns, fields, on/off ramps and landscaped areas.
- Mowing shall be done at a height consistent with the best practices for turf health.
- Edging along sidewalks, curbs, trails and paved areas to maintain a clean, crisp appearance.
- Trimming around trees, playground equipment, fences, benches, light poles, signage, buildings and other obstacles.
- Removal or dispersal of grass clippings from turf and hard surfaces.

B. Fertilization

- The contractor will provide a fertilization plan.
- Landscape Maintenance:
- Provide weed control services in landscaped beds, fence lines, and hardscape areas, using environmentally safe methods or as specified.
- Seasonal plantings, mulching, pruning, and general landscape maintenance as required.
- Pruning and shaping of shrubs and hedges as needed.
- Insect and pest control as needed, using environmentally friendly methods when possible
- Annual inspections of landscaping and tree health, making recommendations for future plantings or replacement.

C. General Conditions

- Work shall be performed during normal daylight hours unless otherwise authorized
- Contractor must coordinate work to minimize disruption to park users
- All services must meet municipal quality and safety standards

- **Optional Renewals:** Up to two (2) additional one-year terms, subject to satisfactory performance and municipal approval.

Prices shall include all labor, equipment, fuel, overhead, and incidentals. No additional charges will be permitted unless approved in writing by the Town of Bargersville.

7. Vendor Qualifications

Each respondent shall include:

- Company name, address, and years in business
- Description of experience providing municipal or public park maintenance
- At least three (3) references from municipalities or similar entities
- Proof of required licenses and registrations
- Certificate of Insurance meeting municipal minimum requirements, including:
 - General Liability
 - Workers' Compensation

8. Compliance and Legal Requirements

- Contractor shall comply with all federal, state and local laws, ordinances, and regulations
- Contractor shall be responsible for the acts and omissions of its employees and subcontractors
- The Town is exempt from sales and use tax

9. Evaluation and Award

Quotes will be evaluated based on:

- Total cost
- Contractor experience and qualifications
- References and past performance
- Ability to meet service scheduling requirements

The Bargersville Park Board may award the contract to the lowest responsible and responsive vendor or may reject any or all quotations in the best interest of the town.
